

Walter Lloyd – Auction of barn contents - Harness

1. A working set Driving harness for Fell pony, comprising saddle & britching, britching straps, crupper, back band and tugs, pair leather reins.
2. another set, as above,
3. another, as above
4. one full set English driving harness with 17" patent leather collar with brown leather lining.
5. pair of army traces, leather covered steel cable, Mason & Sons 1917 (Royal Artillery type)
6. pair of army traces, as above
7. pair of army traces, leather & rope
8. pair of leather and steel cable army traces, Rawle 1940
9. four single army traces, not matched
10. nine leather traces, assorted
11. three breast collars, pony size
12. five back-bands with tugs
13. two pairs pony size hames with leather traces attached, two pairs hames without traces
14. one set of pony size cart harness with britching.
15. one leather-lined collar, 20 inch, with short traces, complete, with bottom straps
16. one patent leather brown lined collar, 20 inch, with short traces & bottom strap.
17. one 19 inch collar
18. one plaited straw Irish working horse collar (very rare – never seen one like it.)
19. one modern hackamore bridle
20. two good carthorse bridles
21. one pair of pair-harness driving saddles with cruppers
22. as above with britchings
23. one pair hames with good leather traces plus one spare trace
24. one box of oddments - britchings, backbands, blinkers, tugs and various straps
25. bits: two straight, one snaffle
26. one unidentified item? (bull marking harness ?)
